St. Joseph School utilizes the Accelerated Reading program in order to determine the reading level of individual students. Teacher made tests, rubrics, and tests taken from the textbooks complete the non-ISTEP assessment program. Some of the other testing programs at St. Joseph School include the following:

- 3. LOLLIPOP Kindergarten Readiness Test
- 4. Scholastic School Readiness Test
- 5. Accelerated Reader assessments (STAR tests)
- 6. DIBELS and DIBELS Next
