



St. Joseph School, Grade 4, 2011 Language Arts Growth Target Results




St. Joseph School, Grade 4, 2011 Math Growth Target Results



St. Joseph School, Grade 5, 2011 Language Arts Growth Target Results





St. Joseph School, Grade 5, 2011, Math Growth Target Results

The data obtained from the annual performance report suggests that St. Joseph students consistently perform at levels at or above those comparable schools in grades 4 & 5. In order to keep scores consistently at or above average, the staff will continue invest a substantial amount of time into developing teaching strategies that meet the most diverse learner and will continue to utilize best practices. Primary teachers will collaborate in order to implement and develop strong fundamental skills and practices among all children. Grade 3 will emphasize test taking strategies and writing to the prompt. Problems solving in math will be stressed as well.

The use of technology in the classroom will also be emphasized. Interactive whiteboards have been purchased and installed in each classroom. An 18 unit set of student response "clickers" has been purchased and made available for classroom use upon demand.
