Old Business

- Need to research the best storage for alumni information
- By-laws need to be looked through and updated. It was suggested that this
 be done every August or September meeting. Then any changes will need
 to be approved by the Parish Council.
- Discussed need to add a 6th member to the School Council

New Business

- Pathways- all teachers have to be certified to teach religion
 - Requires 4 hours of instruction per teacher
 - 18 months for all schools in diocese to complete
- Wellness 2017-2018
 - Will be creating a Wellness Committee
 - Our current policy is patterned after the Diocese Wellness Policy
 - School Council wants to see snacks provided by the school after this school year and as it had been prior to the 2016-2017 school year.
 - This is due to the types of snacks that are currently being brought by students from home.
 - It is the best way to ensure that a nutritious snack is provided to each student and that the Wellness Policy is being followed.
- Audrey attended the November Parish Council meeting and reported to the council that we would like to have a Technology Fund established. The fund would be from any book fund money that is not used for new books and subscriptions each year and used for any needed technology subscriptions, maintenance, etc. The Finance Committee is going to discuss it.
