What We Are Learning

Language Arts

We practiced reading and spelling words with ir, er, and ur. We discussed cause and effect. We worked with adjectives that describe and learned about the inflectional ending -er (helper, worker). Our main story this week was Kitten's First Full Moon.

Math

We learned that when a two-digit number is added to a one-digit number, the ones are added to the ones. When a two-digit number is added to a multiple of ten, the tens are added to the tens. We used hundreds charts, number lines, and drawings to help us solve addition problems.

Religion

We discussed the importance of prayer. We learned that prayer is listening and talking to God. We discovered some different ways to pray. We can praise God, pray an asking prayer, ask for forgiveness, and thank him. We read that when we pray, God is always listening. We discussed things we could pray for at different times of the day.
