## What We Are Learning

### Language Arts

We practiced reading and spelling words with the long e sound spelled with y and -ey at the end of words. In grammar we learned about adverbs that tell when and practiced using commas in a series. Our main story this week was Koko and Penny.

### Math

This week we used place-value blocks to compare 2 two-digit numbers. We compared two numbers using a greater than, a less than, or an equal to symbol. We compared and wrote two-digit numbers that are greater than or less than other two-digit numbers. We used clues to solve riddles and find secret numbers.

### Religion
