What We Are Learning

Language Arts

We have spent the week reading bear stories. We read both fiction and non-fiction stories about Teddy Bears and real bears. Our favorite was <u>Corduroy</u>. We reviewed nouns, prepositional phrases, silent letters, main idea, opinion writing, and other language arts concepts.

<u>Math</u>
