What We Are Learning

Language Arts

We practiced reading and spelling words with r-controlled vowels air, are, and ear. We discussed the author's purpose for writing a story. In grammar we discussed adverbs that tell how and reviewed abbreviations for name titles. Our main story this week was <u>Happy Birthday U.S.A.</u>

<u>Math</u>

We started work on Topic 15 - Equal Shares of Circles and Rectangles. We determined whether shapes are divided into equal shares. We divided shapes into 2 and 4 equal shares and used words to describe those shares. We discussed halves, fourths, and quarters.
